Q: What is a domain name?

A: A domain name is a unique identification on the internet which allows web users to locate a website on the internet.

Q: How long does it take for a domain name to be registered?

A: The registration process of a new domain name requires 2 weeks

Q: How long does it take to transfer a domain name?

A: The process takes 2 weeks upon the relevant document and approval from the user's previous hosting company is available.

Q: How long will it take for the web hosting and server hosting account to be ready?

A: 1 week and 3 days respectively. A welcome letter with all the necessary users name and password will be sent to you due course.

Q: How can I create a website?

A: There are a number of ways to create a website. You can use a text editor if you are familiar with HTML coding, or use application such as Microsoft Frontpage and Dreamweaver.

Q: How do I upload my files to the website?

A: FTP can be used, there are a number of free FTP tools in the market, or you can upload directly from MS Front Page and Dreamweavers. For details please refer to the user guide.

Q: How do I access or view my website?

A: Use an internet browser and type the domain name with or without the "www." in front of it.

Q: Am I being restricted to certain traffic/bandwidth?

A: It varies between different plans, for details please refer to the tariff plan
