1. Introduction

This User Guide is made for those Subscribers access to the WAP portal of EasyWatch system. This document describes the WAP portal operations and the input requirements for each operation.

3. Flows

3.1. Login

Subscriber may access the Platform through a WAP browser on 2.5G and 3G networks. To Login, User Can:

- Visiting the link http://pccweasywatch.imsbiz.com/biz/wap
- Through WAP Push Message generated by EasyWatch.

Default PIN would be 0000.

3.1.1. Direct Login

After Access to the EasyWatch WAP Home Page, User can input Mobile Number and corresponding PIN to Login.

3.2. Change PIN

3.3. Select Network

User should select the Nework currently connecting to the EasyWatch System.

User may select:

- GPRS (30kbps bandwidth)
- 3G (60kbps bandwidth)

For different Network, the streaming quality is different.
